ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship, which will be paid in two \$500 increments, the applicant must:

1. be a family member (legal guardian or grandchild) of a current FCSTAT member who has been a member for five consecutive years, including current membership year.
2. be a high school graduate or graduate candidate for the application year, with an overall GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale; have a minimum SAT score of 850 or minimum ACT score of 21; and plan to enroll in an undergraduate program in an accredited four-year college or university or two year junior college maintaining a minimum of 12 hours per semester, *OR*
be currently enrolled in an undergraduate program in an accredited four-year college or university or two year junior college maintaining a minimum of 12 hours per semester with an overall GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
3. To receive the 1st and 2nd \$500 payment, the applicant must maintain a minimum of 12 hours per semester at an accredited four year college or university or two year junior college with an overall GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. An official sealed transcript must be sent to the FCSTAT office in order to receive the 1st and 2nd \$500 payment.
4. Student is eligible to apply as a senior in high school and/or as a freshman in college.

REQUIREMENTS

Use additional paper for the following requested information.

1. Applicant must include a **TYPED, SIGNED AND DATED** essay of 300 words or less addressing the following:
 - a. Career goals and future plans
 - b. why the scholarship is desired
 - c. a summary of the family's financial obligations and resources
 - d. the need for financial assistance, illustrating the applicant's and the family's prospect of satisfying those needs.
 - e. Any special circumstances that might influence the applicant's or family's financial needs should be identified.
2. If applying while a high school senior, application must include one **Official High School Transcript** with grades from 9th grade through fall semester of applicant's senior year. If applying while a college freshman, application must include one **Official High School Transcript** with grades from 9th grade through spring semester of applicant's senior year **and** one **Official College Transcript** with grades.
3. **THREE** letters of recommendation (from non-family members) are required.
4. Application packet must include a JPG photograph on a CD or sent via email to fcstat@sbcglobal.net

Send **ORIGINAL** completed application and required documents and **FIVE** copies of completed application and required documents to:
