Eligibility

1. Major in Family and Consumer Sciences Education.
2. Have attained at least a sophomore standing in a Texas college or university.
3. Have been an active member of an affiliated FCSTATss chapter for at least one year prior to membership year of application.
4. Have an overall grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 system in Family and Consumer Sciences Education courses.

Rules

1. Upon receipt of verification by FCSTAT of the scholarship recipient's entrance to a college or university, \$500 shall be disbursed to the Registrar or Financial Officer of the college or university.
2. This money shall be used to defray costs of tuition, fees, books or room and board.
3. Should a recipient forfeit the scholarship, the Awards Committee shall name an alternate recipient.
4. Should unusual circumstances prevent the recipient's entrance into college, the scholarship may be held for the recipient upon approval by the Awards Committee.
5. The scholarship shall be presented at the annual FCSTATss State Meeting and announced at the FCSTAT Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet.

Awards Committee Requirements

1. One original of the complete application packet which includes:
Completed application, one original college transcript and a maximum of three letters of recommendation.
2. Maximum of three (3) letters of recommendation—one of which is from the school of Family and Consumer Sciences (Human Sciences); the others from personal sources.
3. In addition to the original application, include FIVE copies of the complete application packet.
4. **Application must be postmarked by March 1 to qualify for judging.**
